BY-LAW No. 422-2005

**To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law
“To regulate Traffic on City of York Roads”, regarding Willard Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

PROHIBITED TURNS - SCHEDULE XV

1. That Schedule XV of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Intersection or Portion of Roadway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Direction</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Turns</u> <u>Prohibited</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Times or</u> <u>Days</u>
Willard Avenue and Access to Premises No. 3487 Dundas Street West, 35.5 metres south of Dundas Street West	Northbound	Right	Anytime
Access to Premises No. 3487 Dundas Street West and Willard Avenue, 35.5 metres south of Dundas Street West	Westbound	Left	Anytime
