BY-LAW No. 429-2005

To amend By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Esandar Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Road)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Esandar Drive	South	Laird Drive and easterly end	Anytime
Esandar Drive	North	Laird Drive and easterly end	Anytime
Esandar Drive	East	Industrial Street and a point 36.6 metres south thereof	Anytime

- 2.** Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Esandar Drive	Both	The easterly limit of Laird Drive and the southerly limit of Industrial Street	Anytime
