BY-LAW No. 445-2005

To authorize the alteration of Mayfair Avenue/Shallmar Boulevard, from Eglinton Avenue West to Bathurst Street, by the installation of speed humps.

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Mayfair Avenue/Shallmar Boulevard, from Eglinton Avenue West to Bathurst Street was conducted, and although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, the Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps along Mayfair Avenue/Shallmar Boulevard, from Eglinton Avenue West to Bathurst Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of speed humps on Mayfair Avenue/Shallmar Boulevard, from Eglinton Avenue West to Bathurst Street, generally as shown on Drawing No. 4251F-7500, dated August 2004 as may be revised by review by staff and the Ward Councillor, and which is on file in the office of the Transportation Technologist, South District Traffic Operations - West.
