BY-LAW No. 449-2005

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt the rear yard fence on the property municipally known as 266 Arlington Avenue from the maximum height requirements.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A to Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing non-privacy cedar fence at the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2005 as 266 Arlington Avenue, measuring approximately 2.24 metres in height, consisting of 2 inch x 4 inch horizontal rails with 2 inch spacing between the rails, and measuring approximately 4.5 metres in length along the south side, approximately 6.0 metres along the entire rear lot line and 6.4 metres in length along the north side, may be retained despite the height restriction of 2.0 metres for such fences in § 447-2B.
