CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 450-2005

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt the rear yard fence on the property municipally known as 185 Lambton Avenue from the maximum height requirements.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A to Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing closed-board wood fence at the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2005 as 185 Lambton Avenue, measuring approximately 2.13 metres in height along the east side, between approximately 2.13 metres and 2.21 metres in height along the south side, and along the west side of which is a pair of wooden gates with an overhead support beam measuring approximately 2.31 metres in height to the top of the beam, may be retained despite the height restriction of 2.0 metres for such fences in § 447-2B.
