CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 521-2005

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, to increase the fee for the registration of a death and to incorporate a provision for a fee for use of City-managed wedding chapels.

WHEREAS under section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and

WHEREAS as part of the City's operating budget for 2005, Council approved an increase in the fee for registration of a death and increases in the fees for use of wedding chapels located at certain Civic Centres and managed by the City; and

WHEREAS advance notice of intention to pass this by-law was duly given in accordance with section 14 of Ontario Regulation 244/02 under the *Municipal Act, 2001*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 441-4 of Chapter 441, Fees, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by:
 - (a) adding at the end of the heading thereof the text “; use of City-managed wedding chapels”;
 - (b) deleting “\$ 27.50” in Subsection A(2) and substituting “\$ 50”;
 - (c) adding the following to Subsection A:
“(5) Use of any City-managed wedding chapel: \$ 75 per 30-minute period”;
and
 - (d) adding the following Subsection:
“C. All applicable sales, goods and services or other taxes shall be payable in addition to the fees under Subsection A(5)”.
2. Clause 1(c) shall operate so as to rescind and supersede any fee for use of any City-managed wedding chapel:
 - (a) specified in any existing by-law, including a deemed by-law, of the City; and
 - (b) currently or previously charged by the City as a matter of administrative practice under a by-law as described in clause (a), under a resolution of the Council, including a deemed resolution, or otherwise.

3. This by-law comes into force on July 1, 2005.
