2. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

3. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Yonge Street and Berwick Northbound and Right When traffic control signal Avenue/Soudan Avenue Southbound shows red (M.T. 29)
