BY-LAW No. 547-2005

**To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 248, Parking Licences, to
impose an interim moratorium on accepting driveway widening applications in Ward 32
until new regulations are determined.**

WHEREAS City Council has approved an interim moratorium on accepting driveway widening applications in Ward 32 until new regulations are determined;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 248, Parking Licences, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. By amending § 248-1 by adding the following definition:

“WARD 32 – Ward 32 is situated in south-east Toronto and is bounded on the west by Leslie Avenue from Lake Ontario to Queen Street, Queen Street from Leslie Street to Greenwood Avenue, Greenwood Avenue from Queen Street to Gerrard Street, Gerrard Street from Greenwood Avenue to Coxwell Avenue, and Coxwell Avenue from Gerrard Street to Danforth Avenue, on the east by Victoria Park Avenue, on the north by Danforth Avenue, and on the south by Lake Ontario.”
 - B. By adding the following:

“§ 248-6.2

 - A. Notwithstanding any other provision of Chapter 248, applications for a licence under this chapter will not be accepted for lands in Ward 32.
 - B. Despite § 248-6.2A, any application for a licence under this chapter for land in Ward 32 which has been received by the City on or before June 16, 2005 and which is in the process of processing will continue to be processed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter and, if approved, will be grandparented.”
