BY-LAW No. 564-2005

To authorize the alteration of the roadway by the installation of raised intersections at Deer Park Crescent and Heath Street West and Deer Park Crescent and De Lisle Avenue, and the narrowing of the roadway on Pleasant Boulevard east of Yonge Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** The following alterations are authorized:
 - The installation of a raised intersection at the Deer Park Crescent and Heath Street West intersection, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7808, dated March, 2005, on file in the offices of South District Traffic Operations - West;
 - (ii) The installation of a raised intersection at the Deer Park Crescent and De Lisle Avenue intersection, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7807, dated March, 2005, on file in the offices of South District Traffic Operations - West; and
 - (iii) The narrowing of the roadway on Pleasant Boulevard, between a point 72.5 metres east of Yonge Street and a point approximately 20 metres east thereof, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7822, dated March, 2005, on file in the offices of South District Traffic Operations – West.
