BY-LAW No. 576-2005

**To name the proposed private lane located at 466 and 466 Rear Brunswick Avenue
“Sibelius Lane”.**

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from May 20, 2005 to June 1, 2005, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 31, 2005, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane at the residential development located at 466 and 466 Rear Brunswick Avenue “Sibelius Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The proposed private lane at the residential development located at 466 and 466 Rear Brunswick Avenue, illustrated on Attachment No. 1, is named “Sibelius Lane”.
2. Urban Renaissance, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs, estimated to be in the amount of \$300.00, for the fabrication and installation of street name signs.
3. Urban Renaissance, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
