BY-LAW No. 577-2005

To name the proposed private lane system at 95 Grand Avenue and 255 Dalesford Road “Clockwork Lane”.

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site on May 10, 2005 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 31, 2005, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane at the residential development located at 95 Grand Avenue and 255 Dalesford Road “Clockwork Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The proposed private lane at the residential development located at 95 Grand Avenue and 255 Dalesford Road, illustrated on Attachment No. 1, is named “Clockwork Lane”.
- 2.** Thornridge Homes, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs, estimated to be in the amount of \$420.00, for the fabrication and installation of street name signs.
- 3.** Thornridge Homes, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.

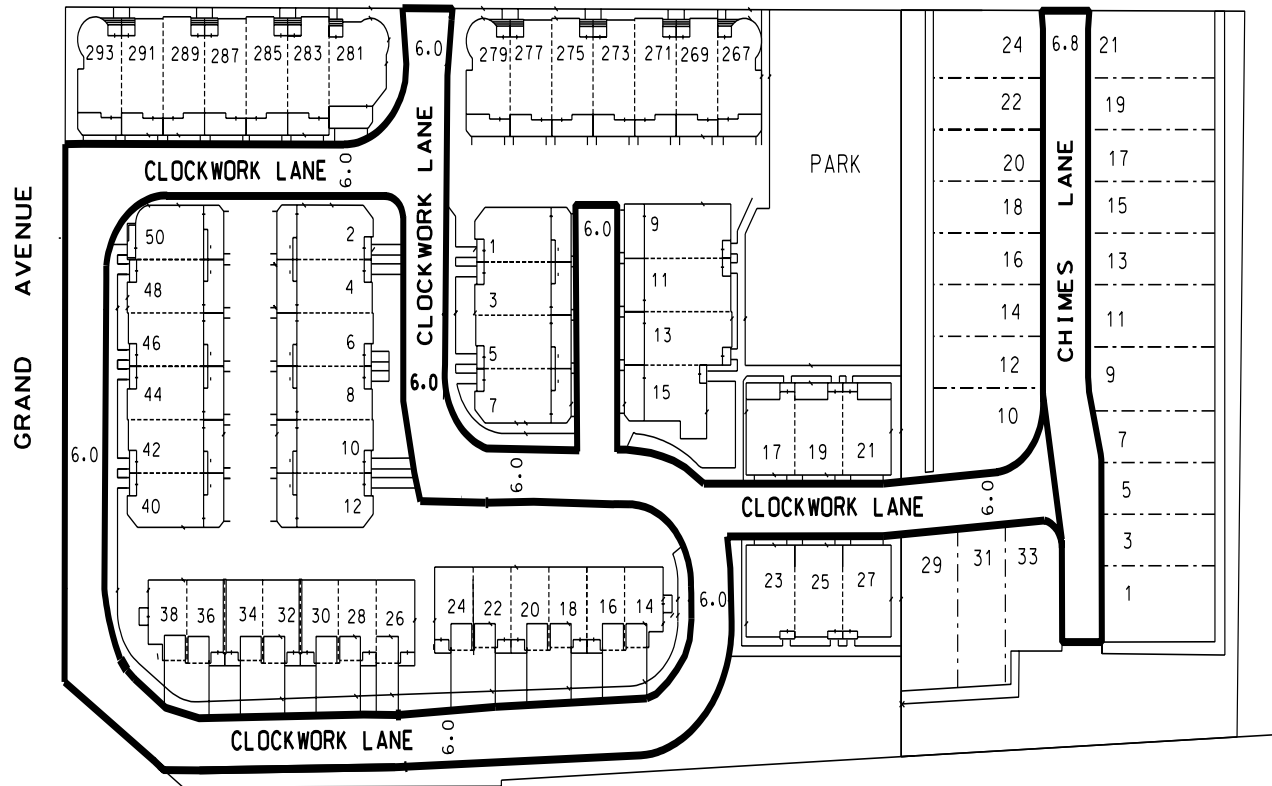
