BY-LAW No. 578-2005

**To name the public lane east of Jones Avenue extending southerly from Sproat Avenue
“Peyton Lane”.**

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the
City of Toronto web site from May 20, 2005 to June 1, 2005, and interested persons were given
an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 31, 2005, and it is appropriate to
name the public lane at the residential development east of Jones Avenue extending southerly
from Sproat Avenue “Peyton Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane east of Jones Avenue extending southerly from Sproat Avenue, described
by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PT LT 11 CON 1 FTB TWP OF YORK AS IN ER79568
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is named “Peyton Lane”.
