BY-LAW No. 592-2005

To name the private lane extending southerly from Staines Road opposite Mantis Road "Chicory Lane".

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from May 24 to May 30, 2005, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 31, 2005, and it is appropriate to name the private lane extending southerly from Staines Road opposite Mantis Road "Chicory Lane";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


- 1. The private lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated is named "Chicory Lane".
