CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 646-2005

To amend By-laws Nos. 594-1999, 504-2000 and 656-2001, being by-laws to levy amounts on certain Public Hospitals and Provincial Mental Health Facilities for the years 1999, 2000 and 2001 respectively.

WHEREAS subsection 323(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, (the “Act”), provides among other things that, notwithstanding any general or special Act, the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws to levy an annual amount upon a public hospital or provincial mental health facility designated by the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care not exceeding the prescribed amount for each provincially rated bed in the public hospital or provincial mental health facility as determined by the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care; and

WHEREAS on September 29, 1999, City Council enacted By-law No. 594-1999, being a by-law to levy an amount for the year 1999 upon certain Provincial Hospitals and Provincial Mental Health Facilities; and

WHEREAS on August 3, 2000, City Council enacted By-law No. 504-2000, being a by-law to levy an amount for the year 2000 upon certain Provincial Hospitals and Provincial Mental Health Facilities; and

WHEREAS on July 26, 2001, City Council enacted By-law No. 656-2001, being a by-law to levy an amount for the year 2001 upon certain Provincial Hospitals and Provincial Mental Health Facilities; and

WHEREAS by letter dated February 3, 2005, the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing advised of revisions to the 1999, 2000 and 2001 capacity figures for various hospitals;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 594-1999, is amended by:

(1) In the Third Recital, deleting the “Provincially Rated Beds” for the following institutions, and replacing them with the following:

Humber River Regional Hospital	927
Rouge Valley Health Centre	645
Wellesley Central Hospital	594

- (2) Adding the following institution and its “Provincially Rated Beds” to the Third Recital:

William Osler Health Centre	508
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- (3) In Section 1, deleting the “1999 Amount” for the following institutions and replacing it with the following:

Humber River Regional Hospital	\$69,525.00
Rouge Valley Health System	\$48,375.00
Wellesley Central Hospital	\$44,550.00

- (4) Adding the following institution and its “1999 Amount” to Section 1:

William Osler Health Centre	\$38,100.00
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2. By-law No. 504-2000, is amended by:

- (1) In the Third Recital, deleting the “Provincially Rated Beds” for the following institution, and replacing them with the following:

Wellesley Central Hospital	594
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- (2) In Section 1, deleting the “2000 Amount” for the following institutions and replacing it with the following:

Wellesley Central Hospital	\$44,500.00
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3. By-law No. 656-2001 is amended by:

- (1) In the Third Recital, deleting the “Provincially Rated Beds” for the following institutions, and replacing them with the following:

Rouge Valley Health Centre	645
St. Michael’s Hospital	701

- (2) Adding the following institution and its “Provincially Rated Beds” to the Third Recital:

William Osler Health Centre	508
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- (3) In Section 1, deleting the “2001 Amount” for the following institutions and replacing it with the following:

Rouge Valley Health System	\$48,375.00
St. Michael’s Hospital	\$52,575.00

- (4) Adding the following institution and its “2001 Amount” to Section 1:

William Osler Health Centre	\$38,100.00
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- 4.** (1) Subject to subsections (2), (3) and (4), this by-law comes into force on the day it is enacted
- (2) Section 1 is deemed to have come into force on the 29th day of September, 1999.
- (3) Section 2 is deemed to have come into force on the 3rd day of August, 2000.
- (4) Section 3 is deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of July, 2001.
