CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 653-2005

To establish an obligatory reserve fund named the Neshama Playground Reserve Fund and to amend Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, to add this reserve fund.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The Neshama Playground Reserve Fund is hereby established for the purpose of receiving donations for the playground at Oriole Park and for funding the planning, design and redevelopment of the Neshama Playground at Oriole Park.
- 2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, be amended by adding the following to Schedule No. 9 Donations Reserve Fund:

"Neshama Playground Reserve Fund Parks, Forestry and Recreation

Provides funding for the planning, design, and redevelopment of the Neshama Playground at Oriole Park."
