**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 655-2005**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 636, Public Squares, respecting camping.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Chapter 636, Public Squares, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. Section 636-1 of Chapter 636, Public Squares of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following definition in alphabetical order:

CAMP — Includes sleeping in a square, including a square as defined in § 636-22, during the day or night, whether or not a tent or temporary abode of any kind is used.

B. Section 636-11 is amended by adding the following:

L. Camp or erect or place a tent or temporary abode of any kind.

C. Section 636-12 is amended by deleting Subsection F.

D. By adding the following:

**§ 636-23. Camping prohibited.**

A. No person shall, within the limits of a square as defined in § 636-22A, camp or erect or place a tent or temporary abode of any kind.

B. If there is conflict between this section and a by-law referred to in the definition of “square” in § 636-22A, this section prevails to the extent of the conflict.
