BY-LAW No. 667-2005

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Ashdale Avenue, Gladstone Avenue, Glebemount Avenue, Greenwood Avenue,
Laxton Avenue and Palmerston Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Ashdale Avenue	West	A point 55.5 metres south of Fairford Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime
Gladstone Avenue	East	A point 112 metres south of Hallam Street and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Greenwood Avenue	West	A point 69 metres north of Dorothy Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Palmerston Avenue	Both	A point 155 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 meters further south	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Glebemount Avenue	West	A point 30.8 metres south of Glebeholme Boulevard and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

Laxton Avenue	South	A point 52.5 metres west of Jameson Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
