## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 672-2005**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapters 169 and 257 to reflect the reorganization of the City’s administrative structure and to make technical amendments.**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990* has been replaced by the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS under the administrative reorganization both the Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer and the Treasurer will exercise the powers and duties of a treasurer under the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS under the administrative reorganization, pending the completion of a review of support services, some support divisions report to a Deputy City Manager; and

WHEREAS the transition provisions in § 169-52 of the Municipal Code apply on an interim basis; and

WHEREAS under § 169-26B Council has authorized the City Solicitor in consultation with the City Clerk to introduce bills to Council to make technical amendments; and

WHEREAS the technical amendments made by this by-law include the following amendments that are noted for reference purposes:

- (1) Section 169-33 is amended to add in a reference to the council meeting date for ease of reference;
- (2) The definition of Chief Financial Officer in § 257-1 is amended to include a specific reference to that person’s appointment as the treasurer under section 286 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS Article I, Interpretation, of Chapter 1, General Provisions, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code applies to City by-laws;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The chapters of The City of Toronto Municipal Code are amended as noted in the sections below.
2. **Chapter 169, Officials, City.**
  - A. Section 169-20 is amended as follows:
    - (1) By inserting “Deputy City Manager and” before “Chief”.

- (2) By deleting “and Treasurer”.

B. Section 169-33 is amended as follows:

- (1) Subsections A and B are amended in both cases by inserting “, adopted as amended by City Council at its meeting held on July 24, 25 and 26, 2001” after “8”.
- (2) Subsection C is amended by inserting “, adopted as amended by City Council at its meeting held on July 24, 25 and 26, 2001,” after “8”.

C. Section 169-52D is amended as follows:

- (1) Subsection D(4)(b) is deleted and the following substituted:
  - (b) A Deputy City Manager with respect to the services provided by a support division that reports to that official.
- (2) Subsection D(5) is amended by adding the following:
  - (e) A Deputy City Manager with respect to the services provided by a support division that reports to that official.
- (3) Subsection D(6) is amended by adding the following:
  - (c) A Deputy City Manager with respect to the services provided by a support division that reports to that official.
- (4) Subsection D(7) is amended by adding the following:
  - (d) A Deputy City Manager with respect to the services provided by a support division that reports to that official.
- (5) Subsection D(8) is amended by adding the following:
  - (f) A Deputy City Manager with respect to the services provided by a support division that reports to that official.

**3. Chapter 257, Signing Authority.**

The definition of “Chief Financial Officer” in § 257-1 is amended by inserting “and as the treasurer under section 286 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*” before the period.
