BY-LAW No. 678-2005

Part of PIN 06000-0201 (LT). PCL 1' RES-1, SECT M1410 PART OF BLK DX (1'RES), PLAN M-1410 DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 66R-21741.

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Borough Drive.
