**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 679-2005**

**To layout and dedicate certain land on the south side of Sheppard Avenue East, east of  
Progress Avenue for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway  
Sheppard Avenue East.**

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the registration of subdivision plan 66M-2300; and

WHEREAS the developer for the site requested the City to lift the 0.3 metre reserve that abuts their site on the south side of Sheppard Avenue East, east of Progress Avenue to legalize access to Sheppard Avenue East, which access has been approved as part of an approval for the second phase of the development on the site;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the south side of Sheppard Avenue East, east of Progress Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06177-0587 (LT).

BLOCK 9, PLAN 66M-2300, SCARBOROUGH

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Sheppard Avenue East.
