**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 709-2005**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Dundas Street West, Howard Park Avenue and Lynd Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Dundas Street West and Howard Park Avenue	Dundas Street West and a point 30.5 metres south thereof	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound right-turning
Dundas Street West and Howard Park Avenue	Dundas Street West and a point 30.5 metres south thereof	Westerly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound left-turning (streetcars excepted)

- 2.** Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Lynd Avenue and Howard Park Avenue	Northbound	Left	Anytime
