BY-LAW No. 746-2005

To permanently close a portion of the public highway Phippen Avenue (commonly known as Parklea Drive) abutting 206 Hanna Road.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway Phippen Avenue (commonly known as Parklea Drive) abutting 206 Hanna Road, be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause 28 of North York Community Council Report 4, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on May 17, 18 and 19, 2005; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the North York Community Council at its meeting held on September 19, 2005;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway Phippen Avenue (commonly known as Parklea Drive) abutting 206 Hanna Road, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 10386-0007 (LT)

Part of Phippen Avenue according to Plan 1908, designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-21974
