CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 784-2005

To amend By-law No. 568-2004 to extend the period of interim control for the lands being the Bayview Institutions located east of Bayview Avenue and North of Kilgour Road in the former City of North York.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto, at its meeting of July 20, 21 and 22, 2004 passed Interim Control By-law No. 568-2004, prohibiting certain uses of land in respect of residential land use for the Bayview Institutions located east of Bayview and North of Kilgour Road in the former City of North York; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto, at its meeting of June 14, 15 and 16, 2005 adopted the recommendations of North York Community Council Report 5, Clause 37, authorizing an extension of the period of interim control to two years;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 568-2004 to effect interim control for the lands within that area of the City of Toronto bounded on the north by the Burke Brook Ravine, on the west by Bayview Avenue, on the south by Kilgour Road and the south property lines of the Toronto Rehabilitation Institute, the Lyndhurst Centre and the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health and on the east by the eastern boundary of the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, within the former City of North York, is amended by:

- (1) Deleting from Section 3, the words "one year" and substituting the words "two years".
