## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 856-2005

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures and Chapter 103, Heritage to change the Standing Committee to which City-wide heritage preservation matters are reported.

WHEREAS at its meeting of July 19, 20, 21 and 26, 2005, the Council of the City of Toronto approved changing the reporting of City-wide heritage preservation matters so that they be reported to the Planning and Transportation Committee rather than the Economic Development and Parks Committee, so as to better align with the reorganization of the City's administration; and

WHEREAS this approval requires an amendment to the mandates of both the Planning and Transportation Committee and the Economic Development and Parks Committee, and to the standing committee through which the Toronto Preservation Board reports;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, be amended by:
  - A. Amending § 27-89F by adding the words ", except those associated with City-wide heritage preservation for which the Planning and Transportation Committee shall be responsible." to the end of the section.
  - B. Amending § 27-86A by adding the following:
    - "(12) Making recommendations and managing City-wide heritage preservation policies, including grant policies"
- 2. Municipal Code Chapter 103, Heritage, be amended by:
  - A. Amending § 103-17D by deleting the words "Economic Development and Parks" and by replacing them with the words "Planning and Transportation"
  - B. Amending § 103-17D by adding the word "preservation" between the words "heritage" and "matters".
