BY-LAW No. 857-2005

**To rename part of Bales Avenue, south of Avondale Avenue, as
“Harrison Garden Boulevard”.**

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 2 to September 16, 2005, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 19, 2005, and it is appropriate to rename part of Bales Avenue, south of Avondale Avenue, as “Harrison Garden Boulevard”;

1. Part of the public highway Bales Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:
