**BY-LAW No. 858-2005**

**To rename part of Terlean Road as “Avondale Avenue”.**

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 2 to September 16, 2005, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 19, 2005, and it is appropriate to rename part of Terlean Road as “Avondale Avenue”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Part of the public highway Terlean Road, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 10104-1561 (LT).  
PT LT 1282, PL 1967 TWP OF YORK; PT LANE, PL 1967 TWP OF YORK  
ABUTTING LT 1282, PL 1967 BEING TERLEAN ROAD; TORONTO  
(N YORK), DESIGNATED AS PART 3, PL 66R-20663

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)  
City of Toronto (former City of North York) and Province of Ontario

is renamed “Avondale Avenue”.
