**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 901-2005**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on  
former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Bloor Street West.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	South	Brock Avenue and a point 30.5 metres east thereof	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays
Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	South	A point 43.5 metres east of Brock Avenue and Dufferin Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays
Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	South	Russett Avenue and Dufferin Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays

- 2.** Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	South	A point 30.5 metres east of Brock Avenue and a point 13.0 metres further east	Anytime
--------------------------------	-------	---	---------

- 3.** Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	South	A point 28 metres east of Brock Avenue and a point 12.7 metres further east	Anytime
