CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 934-2005

**To amend former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code Ch. 187, to permit motorcycles to
angle park up to 60 degrees to the curb.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 187, Parking Meters, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke, is amended as follows:
 - A. By amending § 187-1.1 by inserting the phrase: “and in § 187-6” after “§ 187-3.3”.
 - B. By deleting Subsection B in § 187-6 and inserting the following Subsection B:

“B. Despite anything else in this § 187-6, up to three motorcycles may be parked in a parking space, provided that no person shall park a motorcycle in a parking space at an angle greater than sixty (60) degrees to the curb and § 187-3 shall not prevent the driver or operator of a motorcycle parked as required under this § 187-6B from using the unexpired time remaining on the parking meter from its previous use without depositing a coin in the meter.”
 - C. By deleting § 187-6D.
2. This by-law shall be effective as of the date of the approved set fine order from the Regional Senior Justice of the Ontario Court of Justice for the offence created by this By-law.
