CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 943-2005

To amend former City of York By-law No. 1645-89, to permit motorcycles to angle park up to 60 degrees to the curb.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** By-law No. 1645-89, being "A By-law respecting Parking Meters", of the former City of York, is amended as follows:
 - A. By amending Section 1.1 by inserting the phrase: "and in Section 7" after the phrase: "in Section 2.2".
 - B. By deleting Subsection (d) in Section 7 and inserting the following Subsection (d):
 - "(d) Despite anything else in this Section 7, up to three motorcycles may be parked in a parking space, provided that no person shall park a motorcycle in a parking space at an angle greater than sixty (60) degrees to the curb, and Section 4 shall not prevent the driver or operator of a motorcycle parked as required under this Subsection 7(d) from using the unexpired time remaining on the parking meter from its previous use without depositing a coin in the meter."
 - C. By deleting Subsection 7(f).
- 2. This by-law shall be effective as of the date of the approved set fine order from the Regional Senior Justice of the Ontario Court of Justice for the offence created by this By-law.
