## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 944-2005

## To amend former City of York Municipal Code Ch. 982, to permit motorcycles to angle park up to 60 degrees to the curb.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Chapter 982, Parking Meter, of the former City of York Municipal Code, is amended as follows:
  - A. By amending Section 982.1.4 by inserting the phrase: "and in Sections 982.2.6.1, 982.2.7.1, 982.2.8.1 and 982.2.8.2" after the phrase: "982.2.1B".
  - B. By inserting a new 982.2.6.1 as follows:
    - "982.2.6.1 Exemptions for motorcycles

Despite the provisions of Section 982.2.6, a motorcycle may be parked at an angle, provided that no person shall park a motorcycle at an angle greater than sixty (60) degrees to the curb."

- C. By inserting a new Section 982.2.7.1 as follows:
  - "982.2.7.1 Where parking meters have been installed under the authority of Section 982.2.2, if angle parking is permitted, despite Section 982.2.7, a motorcycle may be parked at an angle, provided that no person shall park a motorcycle at an angle greater than sixty (60) degrees to the curb."
- D. By deleting Section 982.2.8.1 and inserting the following:
  - "982.2.8.1 Despite anything else in Sections 982.2.6, 982.2.7 and 982.2.8, up to three motorcycles may be parked in a parking space, provided that no person shall park a motorcycle in a parking space at an angle greater than sixty (60) degrees to the curb, and Section 982.2.3 shall not prevent the driver or operator of a motorcycle parked as required under this Section from using the unexpired time remaining on the parking meter from its previous use without depositing a coin in the meter."
- E. By deleting Section 982.2.8.3.

2. This by-law shall be effective as of the date of the approved set fine order from the Regional Senior Justice of the Ontario Court of Justice for the offences created by this By-law.
