**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1016-2005**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting the  
hours of operation of holistic centres and traditional medicine establishments.**

WHEREAS Section 150 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* grants local municipalities the authority to license, regulate and govern any business wholly or partly carried on within the municipality for purposes of health and safety, consumer protection and/or nuisance control; and

WHEREAS the City of Toronto has decided that activities carried out in and around some holistic centres and traditional medicine establishments have a detrimental impact on the enjoyment of other properties in their vicinity and neighbourhood, and that limiting the hours of operation of these businesses will help to control this nuisance;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 545-183 of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing is amended by deleting the phrase “at any time between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.” and replacing it with the phrase “except between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.”
2. Section 545-457 of Chapter 545 is amended by adding the following subsection:
  - D. No owner shall open his or her traditional medicine establishment for business or permit the same to be or to remain open for business or permit any traditional medicine service or services of any kind to be provided or offered in the traditional medicine establishment at any time except between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
