**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1023-2005**

**To amend Municipal Code Chapter 767, Taxation, the Tax Assistance Program for  
Eligible Low-Income Disabled Persons and Low-Income Seniors.**

WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of section 319 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* and predecessor legislation the Council of the City of Toronto has passed a by-law, as amended from time to time, for the purposes of relieving financial hardship for certain eligible persons which by-law is now known as Chapter 767, Taxation, of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS at its meeting of October 26, 27, 28, 29 and 31, 2005, City Council extended the eligibility criteria for low-income disabled persons and seniors to receive tax relief under Chapter 767, Articles IV, IVA and IVB, commencing in the 2006 taxation year;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The definition of LOW INCOME DISABLED PERSON in § 767-14 is amended by deleting the value \$35,000, and substituting in place thereof the value of \$40,000.
2. The definition of LOW INCOME SENIOR in § 767-14 is amended by deleting the value \$35,000, and substituting in place thereof the value of \$40,000.
3. The definition of LOW INCOME DISABLED PERSON in § 767-22.9 is amended by:
  - (a) deleting the value \$25,000, and substituting in place thereof the value of \$26,000; and
  - (b) deleting the value \$398,400, and substituting in place thereof the value of \$454,000.
4. The definition of LOW INCOME SENIOR in § 767-22.9 is amended by:
  - (a) deleting the value \$25,000, and substituting in place thereof the value of \$26,000; and
  - (b) deleting the value \$398,400, and substituting in place thereof the value of \$454,000.
5. This by-law shall come into force on January 1, 2006.
