**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1037-2005**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,  
respecting Hallam Street, Salem Avenue and Campbell Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- A.** By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Hallam Street	North	A point 29 metres east of Concord Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east thereof	Anytime
Salem Avenue	East	A point 94.5 metres south of Dupont Street and a point 5.5 metres further south	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

- B.** By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Campbell Avenue	West	A point 29.5 metres north of Dupont Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
