BY-LAW No. 1058-2005

**To name the public lane extending southerly from Gerrard Street East to Dundas
Street East between Sherbourne Street and Seaton Street as “Oskenonton Lane”.**

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the
City of Toronto web site from November 4, 2005 to November 14, 2005, and interested persons
were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on November 15, 2005, and it is
appropriate to name the public lane extending southerly from Gerrard Street East to
Dundas Street East between Sherbourne Street and Seaton Street as “Oskenonton Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane extending southerly from Gerrard Street East to Dundas Street East
between Sherbourne Street and Seaton Street, described by W. Kowalenko,
City Surveyor, as follows, namely:
