**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1076-2005**

**To declare the council office for Ward 20 – Trinity Spadina vacant.**

WHEREAS Councillor Olivia Chow has resigned from office by notice, in writing, filed with the Clerk of the City of Toronto in accordance with section 260 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS subsection 259(1)(d) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that the office of a member of council becomes vacant if the member resigns from office; and

WHEREAS section 262 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that, where the office of a member of council becomes vacant under section 259, the council shall at its next meeting declare the office to be vacant;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The office of Councillor, Ward 20 – Trinity Spadina is declared vacant.
