BY-LAW No. 1078-2005

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 108-86 designating certain locations on former Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Sheppard Avenue East.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law "To designate certain 1. locations on Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers", as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Sheppard Avenue East between north side (westbound Sheppard Avenue East) (M.T. 28)and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately

110 metres west of Amethyst Road

Sheppard Avenue East between south side (eastbound Sheppard Avenue East) (M.T. 28)

and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately

110 metres west of Amethyst Road
