**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 463-2006**

**To authorize the alteration of roadway by removing the southbound right-turn channel, relocating the north side median to allow for a pedestrian crosswalk, and extending the median to the north, at the intersection of Yonge Street and Lake Shore Boulevard.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alterations are authorized:

The alteration of the intersection of Yonge Street and Lake Shore Boulevard by removing the southbound right-turn channel, relocating the north side median to allow for a pedestrian crosswalk, and extending the median to the north, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-8313, dated April 2006, on file in the offices of Traffic Operations Toronto and East York District.
