BY-LAW No. 523-2006

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting age
of replacement vehicles for taxicabs.**

WHEREAS Section 150 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* grants local municipalities the authority to license, regulate and govern any business wholly or partly carried on within the municipality for purposes of health and safety, consumer protection and/or nuisance control; and

WHEREAS City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, regulates the age of vehicles which may be used as taxicabs; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has determined that the increase in the age of replacement vehicles provided for in this by-law continues to protect the safety of members of the public and continues to protect consumers while taking into account the cost of replacement vehicles to owners and drivers of taxicabs;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 545-140H(1)(a) of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended by deleting the word “two” therein and by replacing it with the word “three”, such that the clause reads as follows:
 - (a) More than three model years old by year date; or
2. This by-law shall come into effect on the date of its enactment.
