BY-LAW No. 557-2006

**To authorize the alteration of Hallam Street, between Dufferin Street and
Dovercourt Road, by the installation of five speed humps.**

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Hallam Street, between Dufferin Street and Dovercourt Road, was conducted and notwithstanding that the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy was not satisfied, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Hallam Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of five speed humps on Hallam Street, between Dufferin Street and Dovercourt Road, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7815 dated March 2005, on file in the Traffic Operations, Toronto and East York District West Office.
