BY-LAW No. 810-2006

To name the proposed private lanes at 77 Janda Court as "Frost King Lane" and "Pedigree Mews".

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 6 to September 13, 2006, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 13, 2006, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lanes at 77 Janda Court as "Frost King Lane" and "Pedigree Mews";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The proposed private lanes at 77 Janda Court be named as "Frost King Lane" and "Pedigree Mews";
- 2. Gemini Urban Design (Janda) Corporation pay the costs estimated to be in the amount of \$420.00 for the fabrication and installation of the street name signs; and
- **3.** Gemini Urban Design (Janda) Corporation, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
