Part of the Public Highway Dufferin Street being part of Lot 33 on Plan 423 dedicated as public highway by Corporation of the Township of York By-law No. 14169 (CY348891) designated as PARTS 1 and 2 on Plan 66R-22556, City of Toronto (former City of York) and Province of Ontario Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66).
