BY-LAW No. 967-2006

To repeal former City of Toronto By-law No. 20663 as it pertains to certain lands adjoining 1900 Bayview Avenue.

WHEREAS at its meeting held on July 19, 20, 21 and 26, 2005, City Council authorized the City to sell certain land, including a six inch reserve strip, adjoining 1900 Bayview Avenue and authorized and directed the appropriate City officials to take the necessary action to give effect thereto; and

WHEREAS in order to complete the sale of the six inch reserve strip, it is necessary to repeal former City of Toronto By-law No. 20663, being a by-law to dedicate certain lands abutting the south side of Blythwood Road for public park purposes, solely as it pertains to the six inch reserve strip;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 20663, being a by-law to dedicate certain lands abutting the south side of Blythwood Road for public park purposes, is hereby repealed solely as it pertains to the following lands:

PIN 10362-0712 (LT)

Part of Lot 2, Concession 1 East of Yonge Street, designated as Parts 29 and 32 on Plan 66R-22670, City of Toronto

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66).
