CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1075-2006

To repeal By-law No. 78-97 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto.

WHEREAS By-law No. 78-97 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto was enacted “to enable a retirement compensation arrangement for certain members of the Metropolitan Toronto Pension Plan”; and

WHEREAS such a retirement compensation arrangement was never created and the purposes which it was intended to serve are to be achieved by other means;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 78-97 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto is hereby repealed.
2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th day of June, 1997.

ENACTED AND PASSED by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council present and voting this 27th day of September, A.D. 2006.
