**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 10-2007**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86 designating certain locations on former  
Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Kipling Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law "To designate certain locations on former Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers", as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Kipling Avenue (M.T. 3)	between east side (northbound Kipling Avenue) and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately 27 metres north of Hayhurst Road/Northcrest Road

Kipling Avenue (M.T. 3)	between west side (southbound Kipling Avenue) and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately 27 metres north of Hayhurst Road/Northcrest Road
