BY-LAW No. 42-2007

To name the proposed private lane located west of Spadina Avenue, extending northerly from Fort York Boulevard as "Telegram Mews".

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from January 9 to January 15, 2007, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on January 16, 2007, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane located west of Spadina Avenue, extending northerly from Fort York Boulevard as "Telegram Mews";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The proposed private lane shown on attachment 1 to this By-law dated August 17, 2006, located west of Spadina Avenue, extending northerly from Fort York Boulevard, be named as "Telegram Mews";
- 2. Concord Adex Development Corporation, its agent or successor pay the costs estimated to be in the amount of \$300.00 for the fabrication and installation of the street name signs; and
- **3.** Concord Adex Development Corporation, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
