Part of PIN 06218-0142 (LT) Part of Pcl 756, Sec Township of Pickering Part of One Foot Reserve on Plan M-36 designated as PART 26 on Plan 66R-22609

City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Josaly Drive.
