BY-LAW No. 140-2007

To amend By-law No. 31001 of the former City of North York respecting the regulation of traffic on North York roads, regarding Glengarry Avenue at Ledbury Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "XIX" (Stop Signs) of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by adding to Columns 1 and 2 the following:
