BY-LAW No. 146-2007

To appoint Richard Butts as a Deputy City Manager.

WHEREAS under section 140 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may appoint a chief administrative officer; and

WHEREAS under clause 28(o) of the *Interpretation Act*, words authorizing the appointment of a public officer or functionary include the power of appointing a deputy to perform and have all the powers and authority of the public officer or functionary to be exercised in such manner and upon such occasions as are specified in the instrument appointing him or her, or such limited powers and authority as the instrument prescribes; and

WHEREAS under clause 28(j) of the *Interpretation Act*, words in a Act importing the singular number only include more persons of the same kind than one; and

WHEREAS Council has approved an administrative structure in which the City's chief administrative officer is called the "City Manager" and is to be assisted by two Deputy City Managers and a Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Richard Butts is appointed to the office of Deputy City Manager (Citizen Focused Services) and shall have all the powers conferred and duties of the City Manager under Article I of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code as may be assigned by the City Manager from time to time.
- **2.** City of Toronto By-law No. 315-2005, "To appoint Fareed Amin as Deputy City Manager", is repealed.
- 3. This by-law comes into force on the latter of the date of which Richard Butts commences his employment with the City as Deputy City Manager under an employment agreement and February 14, 2007.
