BY-LAW No. 175-2007

To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 591-2000 to authorize the City Clerk to enter into agreements for the provision of election services by the City Clerk's staff.

WHEREAS City of Toronto By-law No. 591-2000 authorizes the City Clerk to enter into agreements for the sub-lease of the City's vote-counting equipment to municipalities, unions, community organizations and others, and contract services of the Election Services staff to supervise the use of the equipment; and

WHEREAS the City Clerk has been asked to enter into agreements for the provision of election services by her staff without the vote-counting equipment;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 591-2000 is amended by adding the following as section 2:

The City Clerk is authorized to enter into agreements for the provision of election services by the City Clerk's staff to other governments and other organizations.
