CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 269-2007

To amend By-law No. 23506 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting Pharmacy Avenue and to repeal By-law No. 65-2007.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting held on February 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007 adopted items 2.14 and 2.15 of the Scarborough Community Council which recommended replacing pedestrian crossovers with traffic control signals at the intersections of Pharmacy Avenue and Knightsbridge Road and Warden Avenue and Firvalley Court and enacted By-law No. 65-2007 which amended By-law No. 23506 of the former City of Scarborough with respect to same; and

WHEREAS it was premature to remove the pedestrian crossovers as traffic control signals will not be activated at the subject intersections for several months at least and the aforementioned pedestrian crossovers should not be removed until such time as traffic control signals are activated; and

WHEREAS Warden Avenue was a roadway under the jurisdiction of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto and the pedestrian crossover on Warden Avenue, north of Firvalley Court, was regulated by Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86 and not by former City of Scarborough By-law No. 23506;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The schedule to Pedestrian Crossover By-law No. 23506 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by adding the following words:
